The Global Problem for Cities

- "Urban Tsunami" 1 million people per week migrating in
- cities are poor
- share air, water, power, housing, etc, problems
- "You're a city manager in Kigali, Kowloon or Kamloops faced with a water quality crisis or waste policy issue. How can you quickly scope the latest ideas and proven solutions?
 - consultants are expensive.
 - Google isn't the answer.
 - academic databases are impenetrable.

The sustainability noise is deafening – where can you find a signal?

- no lack of solutions. - too much complexity; too little consensus



The Proposed Solution –

- fundamentally a collective learning problem!
- how can cities learn from other cities about sustainability?
- "Imagine an Amazon-like online destination where the 'products' are sustainability solutions and the participation of countless consumers, like you, continuously identify the best solutions – all of which are free!"
- "Solutions Exchange": open source social software
- Collective intelligence to reduce complexity & build consensus
